# Welcome to Year 5 at KPS




### Timetable

#### **Spellings**



Weekly spelling assignments will be set on Spelling Shed. Children learn spellings through interactive games and will be tested each week. There is a link on Google Classroom.

#### My Maths



A weekly task will be set on MyMaths. The tasks are short and there is online support if needed. The tasks are marked instantly and multiple attempts are allowed.

#### Reading

We encourage reading for pleasure: chapter books, comics, magazines, picture books - whatever your child enjoys. Children have an online reading record, which they access via Google classroom. They can log their reading at home or in class. If your child is reading a banded book, they can have an additional book to read for pleasure too.
