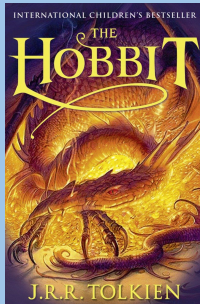
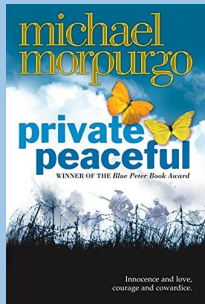


Class Novels
