Independent Learners

In Nursery we encourage every child to be as independent as they possible can. We are celebrating their achievements with them and every little independent skill that they learn counts as it helps them to have more autonomy and responsibility throughout the school day. Here is another reminder of ways that you can help them with this at home.

- Helping them to practice getting dressed and undressed by themselves.
- Practice tricky fastenings on clothes with them e.g. zips and poppers on trousers.
- Letting them use scissors to practice their cutting skills so that they can be more independent in the craft area.
- Encouraging them to tell an adult when they need help with their toileting.

It also really helps us if all belongings are named. Lots of children have the same drinks bottle/hats/gloves etc. and it can cause confusion if they are unnamed. Many thanks for your support with this!
