Forest School

Independent Learners

In Nursery we encourage every child to be as independent as they possible can. We are celebrating their achievements with them and every little independent skill that they learn counts as it helps them to have more autonomy and responsibility throughout the school day. Here is another reminder of ways that you can help them with this at home.

- Helping them to practice getting dressed and undressed by themselves, especially with putting on and taking off shoes and jumpers.
- Practice tricky fastenings on clothes with them e.g. zips and poppers on trousers.
- Letting them use scissors to practice their cutting skills so that they can be more independent in the craft area.
- Provide lots of mark making opportunities to encourage early writing skills.
- Encouraging them to tell an adult when they need help with their toileting.
